Abundance Symbols

- A - Abundant - Species found in large numbers in suitable habitat ans season.
- C - Common - Species found in suitable habitat ans season.
- U - Uncommon - Species may be found in suitable habitat ans season.
- R - Rare - Species infrequently found in suitable habitat.
- X - Species sighted less than 5 times in 10 years in the area covered by this list and are out of their normal range or season.

Habitat Codes

Upper Case letters represent those habitats commonly used by a species.

Lower Case letters represent those habitats less frequently used.

A a - Aquatic - areas of open water (i.e. lakes, ponds, reservoirs, streams, ans rivers).

R r - Riparian - those habitats associated with saturated soils but without visible standing water - marsh, gravel sand and mud bars, and vegetation that is directly influenced by permanent water.

F f - Farm - Land under cultivation, irrigated, or dry.

C c - Cliff - Vertical rock or earth face.

D d - Desert - Rangeland that has not been cultivated.
